Tender Hearts also has thrift stores in Clover and York. 100% of their sales revenue goes to support their mission of helping the homeless. They run the House of Hope Women and Children's Shelter Program and a new men's shelter. They work in coordination with The Bethel Men's Shelter in helping to supply the men's needs.

Part of their goal is to enroll women and men in crisis into a 9- month shelter program designed to give a fresh perspective on life and develop job skills that will enable them to better support their families. In addition, they provide Biblically based counseling, education, and job training to empower residents to get off the welfare system and thrive in today's economic environment.
